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ABSTRACT

Nisa Nuranisa. 181230053. 2022. The Effectiveness of Picture Card Media to Improve Students Vocabulary Enrichment (An Experimental Study of 7th Grade Students of SMPN 5 Kramatwatu Academic Year 2021-2022)

The purpose of this research was to determine whether there was a significant difference between the vocabulary enrichment of students who were taught using picture card and those who were not taught by picture card at SMPN 5 Kramatwatu. This research uses a pre-experimental design. The population was taken from the seventh grade students of SMPN 5 Kramatwatu. The number of samples in this research were 30 students. In collecting data, researchers used tests and documentation. 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
