## CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

## A. Conclusion

Based on the results of research and development of pop-up book learning media that have been carried out, it can be concluded as follows:

- 1. The product of research and development (R&D) using the ADDIE model is a pop up book learning media on descriptive text material for first grade junior high school. The media development step starts from making the cover design, designing the background, typing the material, designing the pop-up image and assembling all the components. The feasibility of pop-up book learning media on descriptive text material according to experts is said to be very feasible. The results of validation by media experts get an average score 4.50, material experts get an average score 4.83, and educators get an average score 4.65. All the results of the questionnaire recapitulation at the product validation stage have very feasible criteria.
- 2. Students at MTs Al-Khairiyah Pontang, Serang Regency, Banten gave a positive response to the pop-up book learning media on

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descriptive text material. The results of the average percentage score 90.8 % with very interesting category.

## **B.** Suggestions

Based on the results of research and development of pop-up book t learning media on descriptive text material, several suggestions can be made as follows:

- 1. For schools, pop-up book learning media should be used in the learning process in order to increase the creativity of students.
- For educators, the development of pop-up book learning media can be developed sustainably with different materials and when the learning process uses pop-up book media, educators must be able to control the class more.

For further researchers, after the validity of the pop-up book has been tested by the validator, it is better if the pop-up book learning media is tested for its effectiveness in improving student learning outcomes.
