

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Based on the research results obtained in chapter IV, the writer concluded that :

The authentic assessment process carried out by the teacher when teaching online by the eleventh and twelfth grade English teachers at SMAN 1 Baros goes through three processes, namely 1) Preparation, 2) The assessment process; and 3) reporting; this process is carried out online using several media when conducting assessments in online learning, including google meet, to hold meetings and provide materials. At the same time, google classroom and WhatsApp groups are used more often during assignments.

In addition, the researchers also found several obstacles felt by teachers in providing authentic assessments in online learning, including 1) Lack of facilities and infrastructure owned by students, 2) Lack of student supervision when giving assignments, and 3) Limited time for learning and assessment. Some of these challenges are indeed an obstacle for teachers so that they become one of the indicators of authentic assessment carried out when online learning is considered less objective.

However, with these obstacles, the teacher becomes more creative in presenting the material simultaneously to solve these challenges.

B. Suggestion

In this section, the writer tried to give several suggestions for several parties, including:

1. For the Teachers
 - a. Increase creativity in delivering material in online learning.
 - b. The purpose of teaching does not only focus on achievement targets but also on student interest in learning which is very important so that teaching and learning activities continue under any conditions.
2. For the Students
 - a. Students are expected to be more disciplined in participating in learning even though it is done online and not make excuses with all the limitations.
 - b. Should respect the teacher more and increase honesty, especially when working on and testing the results obtained from students' actual abilities.

3. For other researchers

Future researchers must examine more sources and references related to the issue so that the results of the research that is disclosed become wide
