#### ABOUT THIS BOOK

his book is written by two authors: Yayu Heryatun and Tri Ilma Septiana. They are researchers and lecturers at Sultan Maulana Hasanuddin Banten, The State Islamic University. Basically, this book deals with **Intensive and Extensive Listening** with an emphasis on how student comprehend several short dialogues or simple monologues related to daily academic and social life through voice recording or video of native speakers with various dialects (e.g., British, American, Australian, Canadian, Indonesian, and etc).

The topics are thematically designed from simple to complex with the aim of developing student's global understanding of spoken language through various listening activities such as detecting keywords, understanding the meaning of words from context, capturing the main idea, and drawing a conclusion. Material exercises are presented in various forms such as (1) finding and correcting errors, (2) matching, (3) sorting information, (4) rearranging words in sentences, (5) completing missing information in a table, (6) selecting true or false, (7) multiple choice, (8) comprehension questions, (9) ticking boxes or words in a list, and (10) missing lyrics.
