ABOUT THIS BOOK

This book is written by two authors: Yuyu Heryatun and Tri Ilma Septiana. They are researchers and lecturers at Sultan Maulana Hasanuddin Banten, The State Islamic University. Basically, this book deals with **Intensive and Extensive Listening** with an emphasis on how student comprehend several short dialogues or simple monologues related to daily academic and social life through voice recording or video of native speakers with various dialects (e.g., British, American, Australian, Canadian, Indonesian, and etc).
