This research is aimed to find out whether teaching vocabulary by using film for pleasure activity can increase students' vocabulary. This research used pre-test and post-test design in quantitative research method. The instrument used in this research was tests (pre-test and post-test). This research involves 64 students as sample among regular eighth grade of SMPN 1 Ciomas in academic year 2021/2022. The last result showed that t-observation "to" that the writer or from the calculation is higher than t-table "t-t" both at the degree of significant 5% (0,05) and 1%.
