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## ABSTRACT

**Citra Suci Amalia**, 191230132, 2023, *“Teacher’s Strategy for Overcoming Students’ Anxiety in Speaking English (A Case Study Grade 8 at SMP Alwildan Islamic School 1 – Gading Serpong, Tangerang District).”*

The research explores “Teacher's Strategy for Overcoming Students' Anxiety in Speaking English at SMP Alwildan Islamic School 1 - Gading Serpong, Tangerang District.” The statement of the problems is: (1) How to overcome students' anxiety in speaking English at school?

Based on the prior statement, the researcher formulates the aims of the study; (1) To observe teachers’ strategies for overcoming students' anxiety in speaking English.

The results of the study show that the first teacher and the second teacher have the same strategy to overcome students' speaking anxiety when outside the classroom, namely English Day and Examination Authority.
