CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

The results of this study can be concluded, as follows:

Enhancing students' pronunciation in the experimental class was seen in the enhance in scores at the pre-test and post-test conducted, at the pre-test the average score of students was 49.05 and in the post-test, the score increased to 64.07, the enhance in value that occurs can be presented as 31%, this shows that enhancing students' pronunciation through the dialog of Aladdin movie is effectively carried out as a learning medium in learning English, especially in learning pronunciation.

And researchers get how the development of students' pronunciation changes through this learning media at the time before the treatment until after during the research. Student development is divided into four stages of development, once, twice, three times, and four times. This development is a change in pronunciation spoken by students during the study.

B. Suggestion

Seeing from the results of this study, several suggestions can be given for the future, such as:

1. Using film as a learning medium is quite effective in improving students' pronunciation skills, especially to focus on the dialogue.
2. In selecting films to be used as media, the background is first analyzed as to what the accent is used in the film.
3. Repetition of pronunciation can be done as an exercise in improving English pronunciation to match the actual.
