CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of The Study

Language is a communication system consisting of a set of sounds and written words symbols spoken or written by the people of a country or region. In Indonesia, English is a foreign language in which Indonesian citizens must learn English first in order to speak or communicate with foreign nationals. The function of language is as a means of communicating with and interacting with others, of maintaining existing social relationships, of each individual maintaining contact with his or her surroundings, by asking for news or simply greeting others.

Meanwhile, the basic idiom is considered as a variety of language that contradicts the work guidelines on the principles of its composition. Idiom is Position its definition differs from the definition of the meaning of its components.² Contextual meaning is a more functional notion that captures that status of the information that is communicated in context: it captures a range of meaning effects that share, as a common denominator, the fact that they are determined in context (be it the linguistic or the nonlinguistic context). Contextual meaning is a specific type of meaning.³ Several research relate to this research:

Several studies have conducted semantic analysis. Semantics can make it easier to understand existing words for students who use novels as a medium to get learning data. By Hakim and friends for years, title, Semantic analysis of the idiom in the novel before I fall by lauren olive. The results suggest that. Researchers found some kind of idiom. The first is the binomial, on this kind of idiom the writer finds five idioms. The second is the proverb but there is no idiom. The third is a euphemism, the writer finds five idioms. The fourth is the cliche, in this type of idiom the writer finds the eighth idiom. The fifth is a declaration of improvement. The number of idioms found in this type is ten.⁴

Another study by Fatma nur sofyani in 2021. Semantic analysis of the types of idioms and their contextual meanings is found in the film Klaus. The researcher found lexemic idioms as the most dominant type used in the film Klaus, including: the first verbal idiom is found in many films. The second nominal idiom is found quite a lot in the film. The third adjective idiom is less found in the film. Lastly, there are less types of adverbial idioms found in films. Then, relative phraseological types are found in this film.

Another study by Dinda Aulia Sinaga in 2020. Semantic analysis of idiomatic expressions in the Central Intelligence movie. This research discussed about idiomatic expressions. After analyze that the dominate types of idiomatic expression used are classified into cliched, such as catching up.⁶

The researcher uses this type of material because considering that junior high school students are beginners in learning English, here the researcher aims to make it easier for students to learn English, if the students read this research, students will understand the idiomatic words/sentences in their textbook. And students also know the kinds of idioms that they can learn from this research.
