ABSTRACT

The research investigates the use of Write Pair Square (WPS) technique in writing descriptive text, specifically it is written in the tittle of this research paper, that is "The Effectiveness of using Write Pair Square (WPS) Technique toward Students' Writing on Descriptive Text at the first grade of SMPN 2 Petir Serang". The research on conducted based on the main problems 1) How is the students' writing on descriptive text at the first grade of SMPN 2 Petir Serang? 2) How is the effectiveness of using write pair square technique toward students' writing on descriptive text at the first grade of SMPN 2 Petir Serang? In reference to the afromentioned research problems, this research is aimed at 1) To know the students' writing on descriptive text at the first grade of SMPN 2 Petir Serang. 2) To know the effectiveness of using write pair square technique toward students' writing on descriptive text at the first grade of SMPN 2 Petir Serang. To answer quaestions, the writer collects data from 70 students's spread in two classes, one classes as the experimental group and another on is as the control group, by applying experimental research method. The population is the first grade of SMPN 2 Petir Serang. The researcher took sample from VII A class as control group, and VII D class as experimental group. The data was gathered through pre-test and post-test because the reseacher used quasi experimental method. Based on the result, the reseacher got mean pretest score 58.48 and posttest 65.11 from experiment class. While from control class the researcher got mean pretest 58.57 and mean posttest 61.05. The score of experimental class increase on 6.63 % it is better than control class students with increase on 2.48 %. According to the data, the score of t₀ (t observation) 4.31 is higher than t_t (t table) 1.99. So that based on calculating the data of t-test that effective of using Write Pair Square (WPS) Technique toward Students' Writing on Descriptive Text has positive effect.
