#### ABSTRACT

Annisa Aulia Rahmani, SRN: 191230054, EFL Students' Learning Strategies Towards Their Self-Efficacy in Speaking Skill.

This study aimed to find out and know the detail of EFL students' learning strategies towards their self-efficacy in speaking skill at Al-Mizan Islamic Boarding School. This research was conducted with qualitative method. The participants of this research are 21 EFL students from grade 11 of Al-Mizan Islamic Boarding School. The instruments of this research are questionnaires and interview. 
