ABSTRACT

This research is aimed to investigate the influence of using Annotation strategy toward student's reading comprehension on recount text at the eighth grade of SMPN 1 Wanasalam, Lebak - Banten. The method used in this this research is Quasi-Experimental. The population are students at the eighth grade of SMPN 1 Wanasalam and the sample from class A and class B, Class A (Control Class) consists of 25 students and class B (Experimental Class) consists of 25 students which are selected by using random sampling. This research used pre-test and post-test technique. Data analysis used for statistial test used the t-test. Moreover, the results of the post-test revealed that the experimental class has a significantly higher score than the control class. In addition, the results of the Independent Sample T-Test revealed that the sig-2 tailed value is 0.32, while the alpha (α) is 0.05 which is 0.32<0.05. It means that Ha (Alternative Hypothesis) of research is accepted and Ho (Null Hypothesis) is rejected. This is also supported by the results of the Effect Size test which has a value 2.69 and the category has strong effect (significant). Therefore it has proven and concluded that the use of Annotation strategy has significant influence toward students' reading comprehension on recount text at the eighth grade of SMPN 1 Wanasalam, Lebak-Banten. Thus, the use of Annotation strategy suggested toward students' reading comprehension on recount text.
