This research is aimed to analyze the generic structure, language feature and social function of narrativet text on TED Talks videos YouTube channel to see whether it is accordance with the basic competence in curriculum 2013 of English Lesson learning narrative text for 10th grade student Senior High School. A qualitative research with content analysis methodology was used in this research. The research data are transcript of four videos that are in mythical and legend category under title: The Tale od the Boy who Tricked the Devil by Iseult Gillespie, The Japanese Folktale of the Selfish Scholar by Iseult Gillespie, The Twins who Tricked the Maya Gods of Death by Ilan Stavans, and The Myth of Anansi, the Trickster Spider by Emily Zobel Marshal. 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
