CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusion

In this chapter, the researcher would like to conclude the research based on the data obtained and the formulation of the problem submitted in the previous chapter.

In the research finding show that the 6 types of parental involvement there are differences in result scores. In this research, decision making types were categorized into lowest score with 5%, collaborating with community into with score 11%, volunteering types with the score 12%, parenting got the score 15%, learning at home became the second higher score 28%, and the highest score was communicating with 30%. Higher parental involvement tends to be related to higher students' English achievement. It can be said that parental involvement has a positive impact on students' achievement in English. Teachers also agree that students' English achievement can improve and get higher score because the parents' guide and assist their children's education live.

The teachers' perspectives of parents' involvement are positive. English teachers feel appreciated when parents also ask about their children's progress at school. The communication is on of the important and the hightest aspect in this research, because to get the goals of students' achievement, teachers and parents have to involved in students' education.

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SDIT BUNAYYA school greatly facilitates parental involvement but there is no special program for the development of students' English achievement.
