CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the study

English is a worldwide language.¹ Many countries around the world believe that learning the English language is essential for students and society as a whole. This situation necessitated the mastery of four fundamental English skills. According to Brown, learning English is difficult because the language requires four basic skills, Listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Listening is an important skill in learning.² There are some skills that must be prioritized when learning English, and one of them is listening. In addition, there are acquires three additional abilities: grammar, vocabulary, and pronounciation. All of these elements are important and should be learned if you want to master English. Listening is one of the most important competencies that allows people to gain knowledge and information while also achieving the ability to communicate with others.

Listening is one of important skill that we must have in order to increase our knowledge of our language. However, the reality is that both at the school or college level the teachers or lecturers deliver material using the

According to Brown "Listening is the major component in language learning and teaching because in the classroom learners do more listening than speaking." It means that listening is an important thing in daily life.⁴

Furthermore, listening is a complex interactive process in which learners interpret what they know and what they hear and then apply linguistic knowledge to the message's comprehension.
