This study aims to determine and describe the implementation of Vygotsky's cognitive learning theory at SMPIT Al-Masykar Bina Insani which uses the Merdeka Curriculum. This study explores the application of Vvgotskv's cognitive learning theory in the context of the Merdeka Curriculum, especially in teaching English to seventh grade students at SMP-IT Al-Masykar Bina Insani. The research method used is a qualitative descriptive method, data collected through classroom observation interviews were and documentation.
