## **CHAPTER I**

#### INTRODUCTION

## A. Research Background

Many foreign languages have entered Indonesia. Foreign languages are one of the basic skills needed in this 4.0 revolution era. As a basic capability that needs to be mastered in the 4.0 era, the use of foreign languages has received special attention, one of which is in the field of education. Mastery of foreign languages is also one of the natural resources in the field of education. Mastery of foreign languages is also an absolute prerequisite for accessing sources of information both in writing and orally.

According to Law No. 24 of 2009 in article 29 paragraph 1, it is stated that the language of instruction can use foreign languages for purposes that support students' foreign language skills. Therefore, foreign languages are important and mandatory to learn, even some educational institutions require students to be able to speak foreign languages, one of which needs to be learned is English. The purpose of mastering this foreign language can basically function in terms of communication, namely as a means of communication between individuals to build social relationships and gain more understanding.

English is an international language, so it is widely used to communicate between nations. According to David Crystal, English acts as a global language, because this language has been recognized in every country. English is used as a learning and communication tool in various countries. In some countries English is used as a second language or

foreign language. Having the ability to speak English as an international language turns out to be one of the requirements for someone to continue their work or study in the country or abroad. To measure a person's English language skills, an international standardized test is needed. These international standardized tests can be grouped based on the purpose of foreign countries and the purpose of study or work abroad.

International standardized tests aimed at continuing into the world of work use TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication). TOEIC is an international standardized English language test for people who use English as their main language. The TOEIC test is designed to measure English communication skills for people who work in an international environment.

The Directorate of Vocational Development has developed a program to facilitate competency improvement and certification of vocational students in English. In 2007 the government has created the SMK English Challenge program and runs until 2023, namely by holding international communication skills certification activities specifically for SMK students with the Test of English International Communication (TOEIC). The English Challenge program is a competency facility and foreign language certification for SMK students with TOEIC. By holding this SMK English Challenge program, it aims to test the English language skills of vocational students and increase students' confidence in speaking English as evidenced by international standard assessments.

Currently, the Directorate of Development has created a program to facilitate the improvement of competence and certification of vocational students in English. Therefore, in 2023, the SMK English challenge 2023

has been opened with the aim of training students in carrying out the TOEIC test later and providing *additional value* for Indonesian SMK students to work in multinational and international companies.

In order to increase global competitiveness in the midst of the development of this era, the Directorate of SMK is again organizing the SMK English challenge 2023 with the aim of training students in carrying out the TOEIC test later and also providing additional value for Indonesian SMK students to work in multinational and international companies.

TOEIC is one of the tests designed, developed, and managed by the Educational Testing Service (ETS). In this TOEIC test measures the ability in 4 language fields, namely speaking, writing, reading and listening, the value score by CEFR is what is needed in the world of work. This TOEIC test can measure daily skills in the international workforce. The score results can measure employee skills whether they have English communication skills with other people at work. Therefore TOEIC is a test to measure the ability of people in the world of work in an international work environment. The TOEIC score results also determine that a person has good communication skills with other people in the world of work.

Currently, there are more than 1000 companies in the country and abroad that use the TOEIC test as a requirement in recruiting their employees. In Indonesia, companies held by BUMN make the TOEIC test one of the requirements in applying for a job. The minimum score is 400-600. The company PT Garuda Maintenance Facility AeroAsia is one of the companies held by SOEs that has a minimum score of 475. In addition, there are also private companies such as PT Krakatau Posco,

ConocoPhillips and others that use the TOEIC test as one of the requirements in applying for a job.

With the research title "An Analysis of The Students' Difficulties in Reading Section on TOEIC (A Descriptive Qualitative Research at SMK YP Fatahillah 1 Cilegon)" is interested in conducting research related to student problems in answering TOEIC, especially in reading tests.

#### **B.** Identification of The Problem

Based on the background of the problem above, the problems in this study are:

- 1. Students have difficulty in doing the reading test on TOEIC.
- 2. Students' strategies on reading test practice on TOEIC

# C. Focus of The Study
