## **CHAPTER V**

## CONCLUSION, SUGGESTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

## A. Conclusion

From the result of data analysis based on observation, questionnaire, and interview it can be concluded that the role of teacher as a facilitator is to encourage and provoke students to speak English with used appropriate method in order to motivate students in learning English. The students were motivated and more enthusiastically in the classroom when the teacher used impromptu speech as a method in teaching speaking. Furthermore, there were three research findings in this research based on the observation at the Eleven Year Students of SMA Mathla'ul Anwar Menes. Firstly, there were sixteen students which got high proficiency in speaking. Secondly, there were eight students which got middle proficiency in speaking. The last there were fourteen students which got low proficiency in speaking. It is true that impromptu speech could motivate, encourage and provoke students to speak English. Furthermore, the students can thought, organized and delivered their idea through impromptu speech as a method.

## **B.** Suggestions

Based on the data interpretation and the previous conclusion, the researcher has some suggestions to the teachers, students and the other researchers.

- In teaching at senior high students, the teacher should know and understand students' characteristics because the students in this stage have different characteristics from junior high school students in the part of how to learn speaking.
- 2. The English teacher must be creative in teaching and learning process especially in teaching speaking, because many students are reluctant in speaking English. At least, the researcher would like to invite the next researchers who want to conduct the similar study in order this study gets improved, such as using the same field but different subject and material.
- 3. For the students, be brave to speak English in the classroom, not only in the classroom but also out of the classroom in order to your English speaking improved, increase your vocabularies and be active in the classroom
