This research provides an analysis on derivational suffixes in Monthly Magazine "KOREA" November 2017. Derivational suffix is the part of morphology. It is a study about breaking a word into its elements (root, prefix and suffix). It is very important for the students to study about derivational suffixes. When the students are able to identify derivational suffixes, they can develop their vocabulary because from just one word can gain many words with different part of speech.
