CHAPTER I

A. The Background of The Research

1. Ehsan Namaziandost Department of English, Faculty of Humanities, Shahrekord Branch, Islamic Azad University, Shahrekord, Iran "Teachers' and Learners' Perceptions toward

Using Social Media for Developing Oral Proficiency. The research was conducted at the department of Foreign Languages (English section) at Islamic Azad universities of Iran. The researcher deals with a sample of population consisting of both EFL teachers (N=100) and students (N=100) during the academic year 2018/2019. This research aims at drawing interest from both EFL teachers and learners to make use of Social media as an attempt to raise awareness about its great effects in shaping the students' oral proficiency, and also to spark their interest in learning speaking. This research was designed as a descriptive qualitative

research in which data has taken from observation. The questionnaire is addressed to ten EFL teachers. It mainly aims at reporting their ideas concerning the use of Social media among learners and teachers as well.

The first previous study was intended to know about teacher and students' speaking activity on social media. The method was descriptive qualitative research which data has taken from observation and questionnaire. While The researcher was designed as a descriptive qualitative research in which data is taken from Document Analysis. The similarity with my research was equally researching about applying social media. This previous studies talk about students speaking profiency and it is different with my research that talk about wrting skill. The partricipant on this previous studies is EFL teacher and students from Azad University and the participant for my research are Non English Students From Faculty Education And Teacher Training. This previous studies aims at drawing interest from both EFL teacher and learners to make use of social media as an attempt to raise awareness about its great effects in shaping the students speaking proficiency. While my research aims to know their achievement on using facebook.

2. Dr. Belgin Aydin elt Department Education Faculty Eskisehir, Turkey. Fostering Foreign Language Learning With Twitter: Reflections From English Learners. this quantitative research is to find out the learners' perceptions of Twitter use in EFL learning process at School of Foreign Languages at Anadolu University Turkey. As a foreign language context, students do not have many opportunities to be exposed to English outside the classroom. For this reason, Twitter can be considered to have potential for the students to practice their foreign language skills as an extra curricular activity. The participants in four classes each with 25 students were introduced with the Twitter activity. 90 students responded the questionnaire designed to gather their perceptions of using Twitter in facilitating their language learning experiences.

The second previous study is talk about applying twitter media to enhance students writing skill in Faculty Eskieheir, Turkey. This previous studies using a quantitative method with the comparison research as the research design of study, while my research used qualitative methode, the data has taken by document analysis and giving questionnaire for this previous studies. And it is different with my research, because my research used document analysis to conduct the data. And the participant in this perevious studiy are students who active on using twitter media in Faculty Eskieheir, Turkey, while participant in my research are students form non English student in Faculty Education and Teacher Training, from previous study obove It showed that most students totally agree on applying twitter as tool to enhance their writing skill. It is mean that learning with twitter better than learning manually. From this previous studies There are some differences with my research in using media as a tool to collect the data. Previous studies above used twitter application while my research used facebook appliction.

3. Geminastiti Sakkir, Qashas Rahman & Kisman Salija Students' Perception on Social Media in Writing Class at STKIP Muhammadiyah Rappang, Indonesia. Almost all students use social media, but few lecturers use it in their teaching process. This study examines students' perceptions of the use of social media in the process of teaching English in STKIP Rappang Muhammadiyah, South Sulawesi, Indonesia. This study was conducted using a mixed method, including quantitative and qualitative data. Data were collected using a questionnaire that collected background information of participants, a four-point Likert scale to gauge the students' perceived use of social media in class, and open-ended questions to gather more data rich in the beliefs, attitudes, wishes and concerns of students regarding the use of social media in the writing classroom. Findings from this study indicate that the majority of students showed a positive attitude toward and a willingness to use social media in the writing classroom. However, factors such as large classes, lack of training on the use of

the Internet, and the lack of facilities could. be possible barriers to the use of social media in the classroom.

The third previous studies is used mixed methode it is included quantitative methode and qualitative methode and it is very different with my research. Because my research only used qualitative methode. And the technique to conduct the data used giving questionnaire and open-endep question while my research use Documentation methode. This previous told about how teacher teach the students by using social media facebook in their EFL classroom. In other hand there are some differences with my research which it investigated on Non English Students writing activities on Facebook. Because I described those problem which not same with the English Students Writing activities. And The similarity with my research was equally researching about applying social media facebook on writing activity. In other hand there are some differences with my research which it investigated on Non English Students writing activities on Facebook. While This previous told about how teacher teach the EFL students by using social media facebook in their EFL classroom.
