CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Based on the analysing and finding of the research, the writer drew two

conclusions, they were:

- a. Singing Total Physical Response Method can help young learners in determine the effectiveness vocabulary acquisition. The students' progress during learning activity applying Singing Total Physical Response Method is improved. It can be seen from the result of the average score of pre-evaluation and post-evaluation. Result of the average score of pre-evaluation (55,8) that is lower than the result of post-evaluation (78,8). The students who passed the Minimum Passing Criteria (KKM) was increase from 33% up to100%.
- b. There are some advantages and disadvantages obtained by applying
 Singing Total Physical Respond Method in teaching vocabulary
 teaching to young learners. They are:
 - Singing TPR motivates the students to learn englih. Students are enjoying the lesson with fun learning. They do not sit on the chair only.
 - Singing TPR is a good tool for building vocabulary.

- Singing TPR can help students to memorize many new words since learning process uses body movement.

However, there are also some disadvantages found by applying Singing TPR method in teaching English vocabulary, they are:

- a) Singing TPR is only appropriate for beginner level.
- b) Singing TPR is only limited to simple vocabularies.
- c) Singing TPR is only limited to simple activity.

Nevertheless, overall Singing TPR can help to enhancing young learners vocabulary mastery.

B. Suggestion

In doing this research, the writer would like to offer some suggestions, they are:

1. For the students

Students to have more attention to the teacher when the teacher convey the material so that they can understand the material.

2. For the teachers

The teacher must teach students to use interesting media, techniques, and methods so that students enjoy the learning process and understand the material easily. One of technique the researcher recommended is through Singing Total Physical Response.

3. For other researchers

The researcher hopes that this paper can be useful for readers. So, the use of Singing Total Physical Response is to increase student vocabulary mastery. In addition, researchers can advise subsequent researchers to conduct further research that can improve this research, because this research can actually be extended to other subjects and also in different settings.
