CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of The Research

In this day people can get a lot of information in the world with just one click. This is due to increasingly sophisticated technological developments. People can know about everything, and can communicate with everyone easily using the internet. To be able to communicate, people use language as a tool to communicate with each other, share information, and so on. Language is defined as a communication system, or the ability to produce spoken sounds. Helen said that "Language can be used by humans to communicate with other humans in various aspects such as social, economic, political, science and education". ¹

English was introduced as a foreign language in Indonesia and taught in schools. The four abilities developed in teaching English are speaking, listening writing and reading. Vocabulary is the core component of learning a new language,

Without adequate vocabulary, students will not be able to understand a reading, cannot understand what they are listening to, cannot speak, or even write. Vocabulary affects all skills, without vocabulary students will not be able to master a language. If a student has a small vocabulary, students will be confused and even less confident in communicating with others because all skills in language are related to words". The media that can be used to improve listening skills and vocabulary mastery such as songs, films, television, radio, etc.

The researcher conducted the research in SMAN 1 Ciomas, especially at the first grade students. Because based on pre-observation, the teacher state that the students have lack vocabulary. As well as the students in the school stated that it was difficult to understand and learn English so that they could not understand what the teachers explained. It is because the teacher still use conventional method, it make the students very bored in learning English, because they only hear what teacher
