CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of Study

Language is a means of human communication that is used to interact in everyday life. Language makes people easy to express their feeling and emotional. We need to realize that language makes us easier to interact in everyday life such as for: ask question, protest, make request, criticize, apologize, thank, promise, say hallo and goodbye. English as the international Language which is used for the most of educated groups around the world. In Indonesia, learning English is start from elementary school up to university. Thus far, many young learners have difficulties to understand English as their second language because it has difference in terms of a language pattern used.

In reading, students will understand the text and get writer's idea if they have proficiency in grammar. Grammar is a very important basic thing to learn and learning grammar is not easy thing for a student. Therefore, students are required to be able to master good and correct grammar so that what is conveyed to others is easily understood. If someone uses good grammar, the

message conveyed will be easy to understand. Grammar is study about the units and rules of language, that is study about phonology, morphology, syntax and semantic. In grammar there are also some basic parts that must be studied and understood which are called parts of speech, consist of: noun, pronoun, verb, adverb, adjective, conjunction, preposition and interjection. One form of part of speech is pronoun. The function of pronoun is to replace the position of noun, both people and objects. Meanwhile, a personal pronoun is a specific pronoun to describe a person or thing. Pronoun is a word that substitute of a noun, such as he, she, we, etc.¹ on the other hand, Karen Kellaher argue that pronoun is a word which is replaced a noun by the name of person, thing or place.² Furthermore, Pronouns are used to replace a noun or thing in spoken or written text. In English, there are some types of pronouns are: the first is subject pronoun (I, you, we, they, he, she and it). The second is object pronoun (me, you, us, them, him, her and it). The third is possessive pronoun (mine, yours, ours, theirs, his and hers). The fourth is possessive adjective (my, your, our, his, her,

their and its). And the last is reflexive pronoun (myself, yourself/yourselves, ourselves, himself, herself, itself and themselves).

There are several things that cause students to make errors in learning English, including: poor of vocabulary, less knowledge in grammar and also caused by their mother tongue which is influences them in practicing English. So, to avoid those errors the teacher should be aware by doing correction.

In the researcher's experience, the students still confused when they should use subject or object pronoun although they have already understood about personal pronoun. Because of that the students often making errors in the use of grammar. In this case, the researcher just focuses on grammar because it is the most complicated and hardest English element among the others. In addition, the researcher chooses the personal pronouns because the students still confused between subject and object pronoun.
