

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

#### A. Conclusion

In Sam Smith's album "Love Goes," the researcher discovered 48 idiomatic expressions that were based on his analysis of the lyrics. The researcher applied the Adam Makkai theory to determine the various types of idiomatic expressions that exist. Idioms into six categories: phrasal verbs idioms, tournure idioms, irreversible binominal idioms, phrasal compound idioms, incorporating verbs, and pseudo idioms. Phrasal verbs idioms are the most common type of idiom. In this study, the researcher discovered four types of idiomatic expressions based on the Adam Makkai theory that were used in the album lyrics of Sam Smith's "Love Goes" song. The researcher discovered 29 phrasal verb idioms, 12 tournure idioms, 3 irreversible binominal idioms, and 4 phrasal compound idioms during the course of the research. The idiomatic expressions meaning in album "Love Goes" tried to communicate his sadness and also farewell to his lover, but after that he realized and tried to heal himself and most diction represents pain and sadness, love and desire.

## **B. Suggestion**

Based on the result and analysis of the present research, the researcher would like to suggest for further research.

Firstly, this research is conducted to give knowledge to English education students about idiomatic expressions in the song. Secondly, learning idiom is essential because idiom exist in formal and informal situations. The last, hopefully idiom is not only used in the classroom but also in every situation
