

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSSION AND SUGGESTION

#### A. Conclusion

Based on a study in class XI SMA Negeri 10 Pandeglang titled "The Effectiveness of Predict, Locate, Add, and Note (PLAN) Strategy toward Reading Comprehension." The researchers came at the following conclusion:

1. Before treatment, students' reading comprehension of narrative texts for class XI SMA Negri 10 Pandeglang was less than optimal in reading comprehension, as seen by the scores of the pre-test result score. However, after receiving treatment, students' knowledge improved as seen by their post-test result. And this is exactly what the researcher predicted. This is demonstrated by the t-test which shows that  $t\text{-test} > t\text{-table}$  ( $4,11 > 2,00$ )
2. The PLAN strategy for improving students' reading comprehension is quite effective. The t-test, particularly  $t\text{-test} > t\text{-table}$  ( $4,22 > 2,00$ ) at significant level of 5% tends to show the usefulness of reading in this case.  $H_a$  has been accepted. As a result, the PLAN strategy is effective in reading comprehension for SMA Negri 10 Pandeglang students in class.

#### B. Suggestion

##### a. For Teachers

1. Teachers should use a variety of methods, strategies and learning techniques to improve the effectiveness of reading comprehension in order to improve student's learning outcomes.

2. English teachers can apply this strategy (Predict, Locate, Add, and Note) in the learning process, particularly in reading comprehension.

**b. For the Students**

1. In order to overcome learning obstacles, students must be willing to ask question and communicate with teachers during the learning process.
2. Students must be enthusiastic about studying in order to motivate themselves and teachers to use tactics to attain optimal learning result.

**c. For the Schools**

1. In order to improve their effectiveness, Facilities and infrastructure should be provided in schools to support teaching and learning activities, particularly English instruction.
2. English learning activities should be better supported in schools.

**d. Research in the Future**

The wants to do more study on strategies, approaches, and learning methods, as well as additional educational material that can be used by instructors, in the future.
