CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

According to the analysis of the research, it shows that the value of t_0 was 6,7 with the degrees of freedom (df) was 58. In this research, the degree of significance in the level of 5% and 1% which in the table of significance showed that level 5% of df 58 was 1,68 and level 1% of df 58 was 2,4. In addition, the null hypothesis (H_0) is rejected and the alternative hypothesis (H_a) is accepted. It means that there significant influence of using tongue twister technique in TikTok application to improve students' English pronunciation. Therefore it could be said that using tongue twister technique is more effective in learning pronunciation and also has good influences to the students or it can be said that using tongue twister technique in pronunciation is effective to apply in the tenth grade students of MAN 2 Kota Serang.

B. Suggestion

Following the completion of the research, the author would like to offer some suggestion based on the findings and discussion. This study's findings revealed that it is beneficial in terms of application and learning.

There are some point that the writer could suggest:

1. English teachers should use suitable teaching approaches when teaching English, particularly when it comes to teaching pronunciation. The subject should be presented or delivered in a way that is engaging and easy to understand for the pupils. If the kids in the classroom become bored with the teacher's tactics or methods, the teachers must develop new ways or techniques that are more suited.

The researcher advised that tongue twisters be used to teach pronunciation after conducting this study. Students will appreciate the learning process as a result of it.
