

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

In reference to the research findings, the conclusion can be drawn as follows;

First, the researcher concludes that the newspapers use three types of speech acts found in three articles of Cable News Network (CNN) they are locutionary acts, illocutionary acts and perlocutionary acts. Furthermore, the locutionary acts consist of declarative and imperative. Meanwhile, the types of illocutionary acts consist of assertive, directive, commissive, expressive, and declarative. Moreover, the types of assertive consist of announcing, telling, clamming, complaining, insisting, describing, reasoning, hypothesizing, calling, reporting and asserting. The kinds of directive include reassuring, warning, bidding and requesting. Commissive acts consist of intending, offering pledging and vowing to do or to refrain from doing something. The kinds of expressive acts are apologizing, commiserating, congratulating, deploring, pleasing, welcome and thanking. While declaration acts consist of declaring. Then the types of perlocutionary acts consist of hearer is doing something, hearer is feels irritated and hearer is impressed.

Second, the researcher concludes the dominant speech acts in newspapers of Cable News Network (CNN) consist of illocutionary acts and locutionary acts. Furthermore, the dominant locutionary acts consist of declarative. Meanwhile illocutionary acts consist of assertive and directive. The assertive acts are the most dominant employed speech act in three articles. It is followed by directive acts in the second position. In this case, the text writers prefer to convey the information than ask the others to do an action or express their feeling or emotion.

B. Suggestion

Some suggestions are proposed after conducting this research as the following.

1. The students

The English students can use this research to increase their knowledge and can help them in learning linguistic, especially in pragmatic field. The researcher hopes this study is able to be a useful reference for students of English Language Study Program who are interested in linguistic analysis especially in speech acts. This study will help the students to learn linguistics deeper. The students are expected to understand the concept of speech

acts. Thus, they can understand more and will be able to enrich their knowledge about speech acts.

2. English lecturer

In linguistic learning, the lecturers can use this research as an example in the lesson. The researcher hopes that this study can be an additional data for teaching linguistics, especially in speech act field.

3. Other researchers

The researcher recommends the future researchers who would utilize speech act as the study to explore the speech act deeper in one of kinds of speech acts. This study can increase the knowledge in speech act and can share to the people who want to research in this field.
