CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of Study

Language is a very important means of communication in daily human life. Language is used by humans to express themselves in both written and spoken ways. It is explicitly stated by Narey that "language is a system of communication structured by it rules of signification, or meaning-making.¹ Language can be constructed in a variety of sensory or representational modalities, not limited to human speech and writing." Based on statement, language is a structure which is changing anytime and used by people to communicate.

The four language components taught in English lessons are structure, vocabulary, pronunciation, and spelling. However, at the elementary school level, only 2 of these 4 components that must be mastered, namely pronunciation and vocabulary components. To support students in developing their language learning skills, such components are used. It is indeed important to remember that pronunciation is considered a complicated aspect type that can be used to learn it. Pronunciation is an important role in daily communication. People use pronunciation from simple activity to complex activity. It is also one of the most important skills that can increase students' achievement in learning foreign language. Therefore, pronunciation is not easy as some people think. Pronunciation is a crucial component for the learning of oral skills in

There are only five vowel letters, but there are many more vowels sound. The most common pronunciation are the long vowels and the short vowels. They had difficulty learning pronunciation. In English pronunciation, each vowel letter can be pronounced with different sound. There are some factors the students might think that pronunciation is difficult. 1) The students have low established pronunciation in English speaking; 2) The student do not understand pronunciation; 3) The students have limited learning media in pronunciation; and 4) The teacher does not motivate the students.

Based on the above factors, researchers assume that the ability to pronounce a student is low. After researchers observed the case, researchers learned that English teachers tended to use traditional methods. In this case, the teacher must develop a teaching strategy or learning media that is suitable and reasonable to the students, because the teacher only uses textbooks and student worksheets, this has an effect on student learning outcomes, especially cognitive and psychological. Traditional methods of teaching English as a foreign language, such as simple explaining and drilling, are unattractive to students and can be particularly monotonous. When learning becomes too monotonous, students will lose interest in the subject.

By using the alphabet book media students can feel comfortable and relaxed while learning English pronunciation.⁴
