#### MENTORING EFL TEACHING DURING THE COVIC-19 PANDEMIC

#### Abstract

The Corona Virus (Covid-19) has affected almost all aspect of life, including the mentoring English Foreign Language (EFL) teachers. Teaching practice has been increasingly emphasized as a vital part of the preservice teacher training program. During the Covid-19, there were a number of initiatives to assist teacher in education program. Between these, online mentoring via social media platforms are rapidly emerging as a creative approach to assist preservice teacher with additional resources. This study aimed to explore the effectiveness of online mentoring during the Covid-19 pandemic. Data were 24 preservice teachers and 4 mentors participated in this study at the Faculty of Islamic Education and Teacher Training, the State Islamic University Sultan Maulana Hasanuddin Banten. Using mixed method design, the data collected from a survey and interview conducted online. The study analysed the effect of online mentoring on preservice teachers. This study also explained kinds of mentoring used during the Covid-19 pandemic. The results revealed that online mentoring was effective because the conditions that required online mentoring and the mentor-mentee talk as not as effective as in the normal mentoring. The results of the study have implications for mentors, preservice teachers, and administrators in designing teaching materials, and supporting from university and schools are needed for the success of online mentoring.


